Access Your Computer – From Anywhere!

Did you know you could use your home PC from just about any location in the world? How about accessing your office PC from home?

Imagine going to work on Friday and not finishing your day's work, then flying half way round the world and finishing off the day's activities by connecting to your own desktop PC. This kind of technology is no longer out of your reach. You can set up long distance network connections without the high leased line costs of the past, instead you can use a Virtual Private Network (VPN).

A VPN will allow you to securely create a network via the internet, allowing you to access data or PCs that are connected to the VPN. For example, you could create a network connection to your PC at home, then go on holiday and connect to your home PC from any Internet Café. Or, you could create a network with another company in another country and have a fully working connection to them as if you were on their local network.

No more worrying about transferring data, or e-mailing vast files back to your office. You can even check that the staff are doing their work, the accounts look right and the invoices are paid.

You may have heard of firewalls, encryption, AAA Servers or IPS, but you do not have to understand all this technical stuff.
